

The Medic NAWA Program - support for universities educating at medical studies
Ministry of Science and Higher Education in Poland

The Ministry of Science and Higher Education is inviting doctors-scientists, doctors-practitioners (including dentists) and nurses, midwives from the European Union or the United Kingdom, **who are authorised to pursue the above mentioned profession** and who have the **competences necessary to educate students/doctoral students**.

The application may concern a person who meets all the following conditions:

- **has the right to practise the profession of doctor/ dentist/nurse/midwife** in an EU Member State, the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (EOCD) or the European Free Trade Agreement (EFTA) - party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area (Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein) or the Swiss Confederation;
- **is currently practising as a doctor/dentist/nurse/midwife in one of the countries of the European Union or in the United Kingdom, or is working in a scientific or research centre in one of these countries** - you will be required to enclose proof of employment in the above countries for a period of at least one year before the call for applications is launched (formal assessment element; in the case of undocumented employment, the application will be rejected for formal reasons);
- **has a diploma confirming completion of at least a second cycle or a single degree course of study;**
- **speaks Polish and/or English** freely in contact with patients (a relevant statement is required).

Obligations of the university:

- submitting the scholarship;
- providing the scholarship holder with administrative and organisational support, including assignment of the scholarship holder's tutor, whose obligation will include, assistance in matters related to recognition of qualifications, if necessary;
- in the case of a doctor/dentist who does not have the right to practice the profession on the territory of the Republic of Poland but has the right to do so in another country - it is up to the university to complete the formalities connected with inviting the doctor/doctor-dentist;
- entrusting the scholarship holder with tasks (didactic/laboratory/practical classes) in the amount of at least ½ of a full-time equivalent.
Doctor - at least 180 didactic hours /year, instructor - at least 270 hours etc.
Up to 12 months, at least 10 months - in exceptional cases half a year - to be determined individually.

Scholarship components:

1. monthly scholarship for a doctor is PLN 7,500, and for a nurse - PLN 5,000. The scholarship may be paid for a maximum period of 12 months, (1 EURO = approx. 4.3 PLN);
2. a one-time allowance for the scholarship holder - PLN 12,000;
3. one-time mobility allowance - PLN 5,000 for the scholarship holder and PLN 2,000 for each family member (spouse and underage children), facilitating their arrival in Poland, including covering transport and costs of organising the arrival;
4. scholarship holder's guardian's allowance - PLN 5,000 (one-off amount provided by NAWA).

The amounts referred to in points 1-4 are lump sum amounts. In accordance with the interpretation of the Minister of Finance, **they are not subject to taxation.**
